<u>INFORMATION</u>

Roads

- Completed road patrols after wind and rain storms
- Met Tulloch Engineer for inspection of Fox Run as per Council's direction
- Shut Power Supply off at Plug ins at Lake Temagami Access Point in Panels for summer and did the same at the Train Station
- Graded Mine Road when possible for Dust suppressant to be applied/ Also did it in spots that needed it after suppressant was applied. VERY Dry! Suppressant was applied to road on June 14th 2023
- Hired Trapper for Johnny Creek road and Lake Temagami Access Road to trap nuisance beavers
- Sent 2 Quotes out for Fox Run Project
- Graded Fox Run 3 Times
- Replaced Flex Beam by Minniwasi
- Installed 911 signs on Kanichee

Water/ Sewer

- Sent Maps to ONR on Water and Sewer around the Temagami Train Station for Bore Hole Drilling
- Signed Quotes for OCWA to complete service work on Generators at our 3 locations
- Unloaded Ferric at Temagami North Lagoon for OCWA
- Cleared around pump intake at the Temagami South Lagoon for OCWA
