### **5 Activations**

- July 14<sup>th</sup> @ 8:18 PM– House Trailer Fire, 688 Pozniaks Road; Automatic dual response – placed on stand-by at municipal turnaround on Pozniaks, then cancelled by MRFD – 7 firefighters and 3 trucks responded
- July 19<sup>th</sup> @ 1:36 PM – Fire Alarm at Temagami Public School. False alarm – 3 firefighters and 1 truck responded
- July 24<sup>th</sup> @ 3:31 PM – Multi-vehicle MVC at Tilden Lake; cancelled by MRFD on route. 6 firefighters & 2 vehicles responded; 3 firefighters & 1 truck held back.
- July 27<sup>th</sup> @ 5:59 PM – report of fire visible on shore of Cassels Lake – unable to locate – information passed on the MNR Fire - 6 firefighters and 1 truck responded.
- July 30<sup>th</sup> @ 7:28 PM – tree on line on fire – 28 Lakeshore Dr. – 8 firefighters & 3 trucks responded – 2 firefighters & 1 truck remained until Hydro arrived (8:30 pm)

### **Training:**

- 4 practices: equipment mtnce, coordinate interior attack, fire control, Ropes & Knots

### **Fire Prevention:**

- Fire investigation – Langskib camp, L Temagami – cause undetermined
- Fire Inspection – follow-up to alarm activation at Temagami Public School
- Approved 2 Fire Safety Plans (minor revisions), reviewing 1 Fire Safety Plan
- Fire Safety Inspections completed at Minawassi & Ronnoco apartments
- 2 day-time burning investigated; owners directed to extinguish – owners informed of municipal burning bylaw

### **Fire Education:**

- Fire Educational display at Canada Day event – promoted municipal smoke alarms program & provincial *Saved by the Bell* smoke alarm initiative
- MNR Fire Crew attended, promoting Fire Smart
- Regular radio “fire safety” announcements on CJTT; Monthly community newsletter fire safety messages; Posting Fire safety messages on Fire Department Facebook
- Participating in provincial *Save by the Bell* smoke alarm initiative

### **Other:**

- RFZ (fire ban) implemented June 1<sup>st</sup> was lifted July 11<sup>th</sup>
- Working on Community Risk Assessment – collecting data for 11 mandatory profiles – reviewing MPAC (duplications/outdated) data, improving risk assessment data quality
- Annual hose testing ongoing
- 4 gas detector – still waiting for sensor for second unit.
- Rescue – commercial vehicle inspection completed
- Pump 1 damaged during practice (crack in fiberglass hood) – obtaining repair quotes
- Chief attended Temiskaming Chief’s meeting – discussion on regional training center
