INFORMATION

Roads

- Graded roads that needed touched up
- July 7th 2023 dust suppressant and put down on Fox Run
- Move speed sign to South End of town
- Completed 2 driveway inspections on Fox Run
- Took down flower brackets, painted them and reinstalled them differently on the poles throughout town
- Sent Maps and worked with MTO on Storm Water Drainage through Town and Wildflower. Had site meeting to show them where catch basins were located on Wildflower and where discharge was located
- Ordered 6 Culverts for stock
- Ordered NEW handi-cap signs for Arena
- 2 Staff members resigned from Public Works, one Retired and the other went to another job.
- HR put the Add out to fill the 2 Vacant positions

Water/ Sewer

- Locates were completed for Wildflower
- Changed 2 Grinder pumps
- Repaired some Grinder pumps as well

Equipment

- Equipment maintenance (wash and Grease) Units that were used.
- Had to installed all New tires on 2020 F-350
- Compactor Truck had fuel straps replaced by Public Works
- Loader had service completed and SOS samples taken of all oils and sent to CAT for Testing
- Yearly Mechanical done to 2013 F-150 and 2016 F-150
- Also, last Dump Trailer to be certified for this year

Waste Management

Push Strathy Dump twice a week, seems to be a lot more garbage this year than other years

- Repairs to dump trailers Wiring etc...
- Dig hole at Strathy dump to receive asbestos and the cover over
- Purchased a 2015 F-250 4X4 with plow for the Mine Landing Transfer Station, it came certified for \$ 22,500.00
- We are having a lot of trouble with people leaving garbage on the ground at the Mine Landing and also refuse is being tossed on top of the Recycle Bin by residents. This is very upsetting to staff as well for having to clean it up and returning to the same the next morning. We have no By-Law staff to enforce any charges and therefore it just keeps happening, Public Works does not have the staff to go clean it up every day so it will stay on the ground until we have time. Also, we installed sign saying **WARNING NO DUMPING ALLOWED** resident are leaving their refuse on the ground in front of the 24" x 32" sign.
- Public Works had an extra Recycling Bin brought to Mine Landing Transfer Station for the summer months to help with Recycling over loads. The only Bin we could find was a rear door opening so I took it to help out.

Building

- Chalet work has been completed, foundation parging, sealing and landscaping
- Helped at Municipal Office for water leak in mechanical room
- A lot of work with the help of the students for the arena maintenance, painting, ice pad repairs, sealing, grass cutting, grass cut at parks, rototilling sand under swing and play area's and trails being opened up daily when weather permits, bathrooms at tower being cleaned and garbage's being emptied, downtown core and TN grass being cut and kept up, firehall in Martin River had grass cut all around building, Rabbit Lake being trimmed as well. Flowers being watered 3 times a week and parks and rec watering flowers for the train station as well
- Had blades sharpened for next winter for Zamboni

Cemetery

- Had 1 burial
- Marked plot for headstone to be installed
