As you may have noticed, I'm a member of the Temagami First Nation Band# 2220019801. In 2017 when I moved home to Bear Island, I placed myself on the parking spot list at the Temagami Municipality Office as there were no places open there and the Temagami First

Nations area as well. It is now going on my 7<sup>th</sup> year and now I believe I'm 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> on the Municipality list.

Yes... Parking is a problem. And since returning I was hopeful to learn that a plan of Co-Existence was being established for the Temagami Mine Landing Parking area between the Municipality of Temagami and Temagami Frist Nation. To date, it appears apparent that nothing has been done in this regard...perhaps because of COVID-19. Aside from developing this working relationship, I add that maybe this should be before the Land Claim Negotiations under issues of how we establish Co-Existence.

During our brief meeting on October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023, I was hopeful that you would set my matter aside as a process to establish more positive relations with the public.
