INFORMATION

Roads

- Had roads all graded nicely and then we received all the rain mixed with cold temperatures which resulted in PW roads being pot holly and rough. We tried again when the weather warmed up but the road was to hard. If we get warmer weather we will try again or scarify it when we can. Can't control the weather.
- Fox Run Guard rails were delayed till December 4th 2023 start date due to weather set backs on other jobs.
- 1 NEW staff member started on a 6-month contract and another starting on the week of December 11th 2023.
- Took out Municipal Water front ramps and floating swim dock/ Ladder, also took out center dock at Mine Landing so we could Winterize boat and put away. Manitou ramps were taking out also except for the floating brake wall one so the air boat can still use it with the safety of pick-up and drop off of residents
- Plowed and sanded roads 3 times so far
- Scraped mine road
- Install NO PARKING ON THE ROAD sign in TN for the winter months

Water/ Sewer

- 2 grinder pump removals for winter months
- OCWA removed a 5hp pump from Goward Lift station for repairs (was not pumping) while they replaced a valve inside the well at the same time. Pump has been sent to Flight in Sudbury for inspection.
- Cote's Pole Line installed NEW poles in Temagami North Lagoon for the ICIP project
- Repaired 2 water shut off Valve boxes in Temagami North with Ray and Sons
- Turned off Water shut off in TN
- Meeting in Temagami North for NEW GAS LINE install at a residence.

Equipment

- Annual Certification on 3 Ton and F-350, also both Units were oil sprayed with Krown
- 2013 F-150 needed 4X4 repairs and was completed
- New Winter Tires installed on 2014 Freightliner T-3
- Set Idle up on Arena Zamboni, Public Works will complete an oil change and Grease it when we get material
- Ordered NEW grader Tires which will be installed when they come in

Waste Management

- Burn Wood piles at Strathy, Briggs and Sisk landfills
- Push and compact Strathy and Briggs landfill that needed it.

Building

- Called Cimco for Arena Start up
- Installed weather machine at Municipal Office
- Painted and installed 2 NEW JERSEY barriers at the Martin River Fire Department for protection of our new generator and fuel tank.
