INFORMATION

December proved to be a busy month for the recreation department. There were quite a few events held that the public came out to and enjoyed, which include;

- Breakfast with Santa
- Elf on the Shelf
- Light up Temagami
- The Rising of the Phoenix
- Memorial Tree Lighting
- Public Skating
- Pick up Hockey

Public Skating and Pick-Up hockey have been a great success. At the time of this report, there have been 9 public skate nights and 9 pick-up hockey nights. Public skating has an admission fee of \$3.00/person and pick-up hockey has an admission fee of \$7.00/person. Between the admission fees, skate sharpening service and canteen sales, the arena generated \$1150.00.

- \$700.00 Entrance Fee's
- \$100.00 Skate Sharpening
- \$350.00 Canteen Sales

In addition to the events, recreation has the arena refrigeration plant to monitor and maintain. Temperature on the ice rink has to be changed during floods, when required, and oil added to the compressors. With having the recreation coordinator onsite doing these tasks, it has decreased the CIMCO visits and costs associated with such.

We have a few upcoming rentals booked for the Community Centre, along with some hockey tournaments.

We are looking forward to the commencement of the planning for Shiverfest and will soon be seeking volunteers to assist.
