INFORMATION

MONTHLY REPORT DECEMBER 2023

TRAINING

- December 5th Members took advantage of the unseasonably warm weather and washed all the Fire Vehicles. A new bumper was installed on Rescue 5, and discussions were had with regards to the new provincial "2 +1" Highway Improvement proposal/implementation.
- December 18th Members conducted vehicle equipment checks on Rescue 5, Rescue 3 and the Pumper 4, and were given a demonstration on the newly acquired LED flares. Members had a debriefing session regarding the callout from December 13th, and A/Chief Christie updated members on the topics of discussion from the Temagami Council Meeting on December 14th.

INCIDENTS

December 13th Incident #37 Highway 11 near #3840 ~ 4:47am

A single Transport Truck travelling northbound lost control, rolled onto its side and came to rest on the southbound side of the highway, partially blocking the southbound lane.

Two occupants of the transport truck were extracted by the Marten River Fire team. No injuries were reported at the time of the incident.

The Marten River Fire team also made use of Rescue 3 and 4 to assist in blocking lanes of traffic and creating a safety zone for all emergency responders. Members also assisted in directing traffic, as the highway was reduced to a single lane for the duration of the incident.

FIRE PREVENTION

Marten River Fire Department Members updated the sign out front of the Fire Hall to encourage Fire Safety and Preparedness within the Community.

OTHER NEWS

A/Fire Chief Christie of Marten River along with Fire Chief Sanderson of Temagami met with Fire Equipment vendors in regard to the purchase of new SCBA equipment for our respective Fire team members.
