INFORMATION

1 Activation

 May 14th @ 12:57 AM: MVC Hwy 11 & Jumping Caribou – Cancelled on route by Marten River FD (dispatching error / notification lag). 3 trucks and 7 firefighters responded

Training:

• 3 practices: Hose Ops/fire streams, use & maintenance of the G1 SCBA, Firefighter 1 knowledge testing modules, equipment maintenance.

Fire Prevention:

- 2 follow-up Fire Inspections, and 1 fire safety plan review outstanding.
- Fire Alarm accidental activation at School gym; firefighter present at time, FD response cancelled

Fire Education:

• Regular radio "fire safety" announcements on CJTT; monthly community newsletter fire safety messages; Posting Fire safety messages on Fire Department Facebook page

Other:

- Spring recruitment drive resulted in 2 applicants starting the recruit training program
- Work continues on the Community Risk Assessment towards completion & Council presentation
- Chief attended May 9th, 13th & 23rd Council meetings
- Capital Budget information sheets for 2024 capital funding requests completed & submitted
- Chief attended online presentation (overview) of the Community Risk Reduction Dashboard project (OFM and Statistics Canada data collaboration)
- Chief attended Nipissing East Parry Sound Mutual Aid meeting in Powassan (May 29th)
- New SCBA placed into service the first week of May.
- Seeking quotations for 6 month rental of a water tanker for the Temagami North water tower replacement project this summer/fall.
- Chief continues to work on Civic Address numbering (9-1-1) requests/complaints from past years.
- Generous donation of \$11,500 from Frog's Breath completed the funding required for new E-hydraulic Auto-X equipment. A HUGE THANK YOU to all residents and community organizations that donated, and especially to lke Laba and the Temagami Lions for leading this funding initiative.
