

Hill Human Rights Awards.** The purpose of these awards is to recognize individuals who have made significant contributions toward changing the human rights landscape and honour their achievements of advancing, promoting, and fostering a human rights culture across Ontario.

The awards will be given in the categories of **Young Leaders**, **Distinguished Service**, **and Lifetime Achievement**. The deadline for nominations is **July 22**, **2024**.
