Roads

- Grade Roads that needed grading after rain events (Lots of heavy rain falls)
- Repair the Temagami Highway sign at the South end of town
- Completed Dust suppressant on the Lake Temagami Access Road on June 13th 2024
- Lots of trees down on all roads due to the wind storms
- Still have Nuisance beaver problems on our roads, trapper been called in to deal with the issue
- Completed Interviews for Public Works and Hired a NEW staff person Jeff Watson from Temagami, lets Welcome Jeff to Public Works. Waiting on approval to hire one more staff to bring us back to full compliment
- Inspected 911 signs install with Fire Chief Jim in Martin River
- Dock inspections completed and work to be completed asap

Water/ Sewer

- 6 Grinder Pump Call outs and Replacements /find shut off's
