## **INFORMATION**

I am pleased to present the Parks and Recreation report on behalf of the Department of Recreation.

Over the spring and summer months, our activities at The Arena, including the Kimmy and Tracy Memorial Baseball Tournament and Canada Day 2024, were a resounding success. These events fostered community engagement among Temagami residents and warmly welcomed visitors from North Bay to New Liskeard.

Various activities hosted at The Arena, the fire tower, parks, and the baseball field created memorable experiences for all attendees.

Here are the highlights from Parks and Recreation from May to August:

- May 18: The Temagami fire tower opened to the public, attracting 1,200 people interested in visiting.
- June 9: The Temagami baseball field hosted the annual Kim and Tracy Memorial Baseball Tournament.
- June 29: We celebrated Canada Day at The Arena, welcoming 250 visitors from Marten River to New Liskeard.
- June/July: We coordinated with Early On to offer Outdoor Family Fun events.
- July 19: Parks and Recreation built a shed for storing floating devices and beach toys for kids at the beach.
- July: The Bunny Miller Theatre screened free movies every Friday.
- August 1: The Arena will host our first Cornhole games, with the Temagami Legion providing drinks.

Additionally, Parks and Recreation has been diligently maintaining the waterfront, both baseball fields, Spruce Park, The Arena facilities, Temagami North, Temagami downtown, and the trails at Temagami North and the Temagami fire tower.
