Permanent residents will be given first priority for both electrical and

- non-electrical leased parking spots.
- Anyone with more than two parking spots will have their additional spots reverted back to the municipality.
- Anyone currently holding two parking spots will be grandfathered in and allowed to keep both spots.
- If you need to switch parking spots with someone, make sure to contact the municipality to formalize the change.
- parking spots will not be available to property owners who are in arrears.

6. MISCELLANEOUS
