**Stay or Go is a full-day interactive training that allows professionals to understand better what women go through when deciding to leave an abusive relationship.**

This scenario-driven training has professionals play the roles of women and their children from all walks of life experiencing domestic violence. The participants playing the roles of women and children are then given scenarios where they must make choices to keep themselves and their families safe. Throughout the many scenarios, the “women and children” interact with various social services and are forced to make difficult trade-offs. This training examines the many barriers women and children face when leaving abusive relationships. It allows the participants to see the financial, safety, health, familial, emotional, and social struggles that come with it. This training also brings awareness to the added barriers Indigenous women and children face.
