RECOMMENDATION

BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council hereby receives the Memo 2024-M-165 as presented.

ACTION ITEMS

Roads

Road Maintenance:

- Completed grading on all necessary roads.
- Cleared trees from roads following wind and rain storms.
- Marked locations for 911 signs.

911 Sign Installation:

- Installed 911 signs on Fox Run, Milne/Sherman Road, and Martin River.

Shop Maintenance:

- Ordered parts and supplies for ongoing shop needs.

Brush and Beaver Management:

- Cut brush on the corner of Kanichee Mine Road and chipped debris.
- Addressed flooding issues caused by beavers; one trapper is currently managing eight different areas.
- Cleared beaver dams blocking flooded roads.

Dust Suppression:

- Applied a second run of dust suppressant on Fox Run and White Bear Court and completed two runs on the road to the helipad.

Road Repairs:

- Repaired washouts and conducted ditching on Mine Access Road.
- Staff cleaned culvert ends in identified areas of concern.

Water/Sewer

Environmental Drilling:

 Collaborated with drillers on Wildflower for environmental drilling related to MTO stormwater management; boreholes were filled after settling.

Sewer Leak Management:

 Addressed a mainline sewer leak in Temagami South shortly after WSP's drilling completion. Contacted WSP and MTO regarding responsibility; awaiting a response.

Water Leak Assistance:

- Assisted OCWA in locating a water leak in Temagami South, though efforts have yet to yield results.

Testing and Equipment:

- Installed a depth finder in a boat for oxygen testing in Temagami North on Net Lake.
- Designed new brackets for grinder pumps using stainless steel threaded stock.

Hydrant Maintenance:

- Straightened security posts around hydrants in Temagami South and North, blew out hydrant boxes needing repairs, and sent valve pictures to OCWA.

Repairs and Training:

Turned off water/sewer at 2 Village Lane for repairs and provided staff training on grinder repairs.

Equipment

Staff Training:

- Trained staff on operating the grader, loader, dozer, and garbage compactor.

Maintenance:

- Changed flat tires on the garbage compactor and completed maintenance on the dozer and grader.
- Conducted a hot pressure wash on T-3, T-14, T-040, and the compactor truck for oil spraying (CROWN).
- Changed oil in T-17 and subsequently oil sprayed by (CROWN).

Waste Management

Trailer and Equipment Certification:

- Certified the trailer and replaced the VIN plate.
- Managed the push and cover operations at Strathy.

Trailer Maintenance:

- Serviced trailers, oiled doors, and regressed jack cranks for improved operation.

Safety Enhancements:

- Installed painted curbs at Briggs dump for safety and a backup camera on the 2015 F-250 for staff, along with a direct charging cable to prevent dead batteries.

Site Optimization:

Retrenched a hole at Briggs dump and relocated tires to expand dumping space.

Building

Office Relocation:

Successfully moved Public Works to the main office and set up the new offices.

Arena Maintenance:

 Assisted with installing boards and glass at the arena and facilitated the start of the Olympia. Additionally, helped with new ice installation and painting quotes for hockey and curling lines.

Cemetery

Conducted a cemetery meeting to address ongoing concerns and maintenance.
