THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 25-1812

Being a by-law to authorize the execution of an amending agreement with the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission for the Municipal Operating Agreement and Lease Amending Agreement.

WHEREAS

- Under Section 8(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, municipalities are granted broad powers to govern their affairs and respond to municipal issues;
- Under Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers, and privileges of a natural person for exercising its authority under this or any other Act;
- 3. The Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami deems it necessary and desirable to enter into an Amending Agreement with the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission to modify Schedule "B" of the Municipal Operating Agreement;
- 4. The Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami deems it necessary and desirable to amend the Lease Agreement between the Municipality and Ontario Northland Transportation Commission to reflect changes required for the reintroduction of passenger rail service;

NOW THEREFORE

The Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami enacts as follows:

 That the Mayor and CAO/Treasurer or Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Amending Agreement No. 1 with the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission to update Schedule "B" of the Municipal Operating Agreement, attached to this By-law.

- 2. That the Mayor and CAO/Treasurer or Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Lease Amending Agreement with the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission, attached as Schedule "B" to this By-law.
- 3. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to this By-law and schedules after its passage, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the By-law.
- 4. That all other by-laws or resolutions, or parts thereof, contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
- 5. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon its final passing.
