1. Bridge and Infrastructure Work

- Wilson Lake Bridge #2: Scheduled work was delayed due to T-bolts being on backorder, with an estimated delivery delay of eight weeks. Contact was made with three other bridge repair contractors; however, none were able to supply the required components or assist at this time.
- Cassels Lake Boat Ramp / Rabbit Lake Dam: Held discussions with TESC and OPG regarding use of the Cassels Lake boat ramp to load barges for work at Rabbit Lake Dam.

2. Recycling and Transfer Station Maintenance

- Completed the rebuild of another C-Can for recycling.
- Performed spring maintenance on all dump trailers.
- Installed new stair railing at the transfer station to improve accessibility and safety.

3. Landfill and Facility Maintenance

- Briggs Landfill: Cleaned and cleared the entrance.
- Peacock Building: Reset and leveled the area behind the arena in preparation for Early Years programming.
- Turned water on at 12 Goward Drive.
- Conducted general cleaning around the municipal office using brooms and blowers.

4. Waterfront and Parks

- Waterfront Setup for Summer:
 - Installed flags throughout town.
 - Installed swim dock and fountain pump.
 - Placed and secured municipal dock ramps.
 - Organized fish huts to optimize parking access.

- Cemetery Grounds: Cleaned and prepared for the summer season.

5. Roads and Signage

- Removed half-load restrictions following the May long weekend.
- Installed speed limit signage at both ends of town.
- Graded roads where conditions permitted and began preparations for dust suppressant application.
- Continued repairs to water shut-offs across the municipality.

6. Water and Sewer Maintenance

- Water Break Behind Docks Plus: Emergency repair was coordinated with OCWA, ONR, and Pedersen Construction. The repair was completed successfully within half a day.
- Grinder Pumps: Installed and rebuilt several grinder pumps. Some rebuilds remain pending due to part delivery.

7. Infrastructure & Project Coordination

- Completed site inspections with Tulloch Engineering for the Caribou Mountain Tower.
- Worked with Mic Mac Construction to design new steps based on Tulloch's recommendations; fabrication is underway, and installation will follow.
- Completed all locates for ONR's new railway crossing signals and arms.

8. Other Notable Items

- Supported infrastructure operations training in Temagami South.
- Assisted with the removal of the old scoreboard and installation of the new score clock.
