THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 25-1844

Being a By-law to appoint the Chief Administrative Officer/Treasurer as an ex-officio member of all municipal committees of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami.

WHEREAS

- 1. Sections 5(1), 5(3), and 23.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, authorize the Council of a municipality to pass by-laws and delegate powers and duties to officers and employees of the municipality; and
- The Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami passed Resolution No. 24-391 at a Special Council Meeting held on August 23, 2024, to appoint the Chief Administrative Officer/Treasure, Laala Jahanshahloo, to all municipal committees as an ex-officio member; and
- 3. Council deems it advisable to formalize this appointment by by-law in order to enhance governance, coordination, and administrative oversight across all municipal committees;

NOW THEREFORE

The Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:

1. Ex-Officio Appointment of CAO/Treasurer to Municipal Committees

- 1.1. The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO)/Treasurer is hereby appointed as an ex-officio member of all committees of the Municipality of Temagami, including those currently in existence and any committees established hereafter.
- 1.2. Without limiting the generality of Section 1.1, this ex-officio appointment shall apply to all committees of Council, including but not limited to:

- 1.2.1. The Committee of Adjustment, established under Section 44 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13;
- 1.2.2. Any Emergency Management-related committee, established pursuant to the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. E.9 and Ontario Regulation 380/04.
- 1.3. As an ex-officio member, the CAO/Treasurer shall have the right to attend and participate in all committee meetings and shall receive all agendas and materials distributed to committee members.
- 1.4. The CAO/Treasurer shall have voting rights on any committee unless such voting rights are expressly revoked by resolution of Council or except as otherwise provided in the committee's terms of reference.

2. Supersession of Prior Acts

This By-law supersedes and repeals any prior by-laws or resolutions of Council that are inconsistent or contradictory to the delegation of authority set out herein.

CLERICAL AMENDMENTS

The Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is authorized to make minor corrections to this Bylaw after its passage. These corrections are limited to grammatical or typographical errors and must not alter the intent, substance, roles, responsibilities, or procedural requirements outlined in this By-law.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This By-law comes into effect on the date of final passing.
