## 1. Bridge and Infrastructure Work

 Wilson Lake Bridge #2: Scheduled work was delayed due to T-bolts being on backorder, with an estimated delivery delay of eight weeks. Contact was made with three other bridge repair contractors; however, none were able to supply the required components or assist at this time.

#### 2. Movie Production Coordination

- Attended meetings at Mallie Pit with the movie crew regarding upcoming work.
- Met with film staff to discuss logistics and coordination.
- Public Works assisted and sold gravel to the movie production.

## 3. Drainage and Road Work

- Attended MTO meeting regarding drainage concerns on Wildflower Road.
- South Roads were graded and treated with dust suppressant.
- All municipal roads have now been treated with dust suppressant for the summer.
- Rural roadside grass cutting has been completed.

## 4. Equipment and Infrastructure Repairs

- Repaired A/C line on D5G Dozer.
- Changed grinder pump.
- Repaired fire hydrant on O'Conner Drive.
- Marked and painted water shut-offs across the municipality.
- Marked all shut-offs on Goward and Hilled with cones.

### 5. Vehicles and Mechanicals

- T-3 completed its yearly mechanical inspection.
- T-14 and Float are currently undergoing yearly mechanicals.
- Garbage truck underwent its annual mechanical—repairs were costly.

#### 6. Sewer and Water

- July 19 Emergency response to collapsed sewer main on Birch Street East. OCWA and
  Vac Truck were called to locate and clear the blockage. One residence was affected.
- July 24 Completed camera inspections and a main sewer line repair.

#### 7. Miscellaneous Work

- Tulloch provided reduced pricing for Tower stair engineering.
- Installed project funding sign on Fox Run.
- Delivered barricades to the Station for market events.
- Picked up two pumps from Xylem in Sudbury.
- Electronic waste was picked up from Strathy Landfill.

## 8. Meetings and Upcoming Projects

- Held meeting with Tulloch, Miller, and staff—construction begins July 21 on Fox Run and TN Streets.
- ONR contacted us regarding rail track upgrades in Temagami South—project begins late
  August. The Municipality is responsible for the bypass and labour requirements.
