Activations

There were two activations in July

- July 11th @ 05:04 AM – Transport truck on fire – Hwy 11, initial report 25 Km north of Temagam1, revised to 9 Km north of town - 5 firefighters responded, fire department cancelled at 05:09 AM with location confirmed in Latchford FD area
- July 20th @ 3:38 PM – EMS request for Lift Assist; Birch Crescent - 4 firefighters responded, 1 firefighter accompanied EMS to Liskeard; back in service 15:54 PM.

Training

- 1 equipment maintenance, 2 practices: drafting, Portable pumps, hose testing.
- Live Fire training – Saturday July 19th, included structure, vehicle and wildland fire extinguishing techniques / signoffs.

Fire Prevention

- No Burning Complaints. 2 inquiries regarding Fire Pump subsidy, 2 inquiries regarding fire conditions/burning permits; 1 Fire Safety Plan received for review
- Follow-up meetings re: Fire Code compliance @ the Arena & Chalet

Fire Education

- Fire Smart Community Preparedness Day July 5th @ Community Market

- ▶ The event was very successful, with at least 50 adults attend/receive a brief outline of the FireSmart program, promotional material and educational resources to take home.
- ▶ We had approximately 20 children come through to participate in our children's activity.



- ▶ A special appearance was made by *Smokey the Bear* and *Ember the Firefox*, a great addition to entertain and educate the kids.
- ▶ Regular radio “fire safety” announcements on CJTT; monthly community newsletter fire safety messages, & posting fire safety messages on Fire Department Facebook page.



Other

- Report to Council regarding needs/benefits/funding opportunities to develop a Community Wildland Fire Protection Plan outstanding.
- Community Risk Assessment annual review completed, report submitted for Council information; 2025 Annual Report submitted for Council information.
- 2002 Rescue annual servicing and Commercial vehicle inspection completed.
- Finalizing purchasing of items funded through the Ontario Fire Protection Grant, OFM report back & guide received July 31st, due before December 15, 2025.
- Evaluating hydrant flow limitations in Temagami North ongoing; Fire Underwriters Survey (FUS) request for Hydrant Fire Flow information outstanding.
- Fire Protection & Education By-law #09-847 update awaiting insurance risk analysis on a proposed fire education program for water-based properties.

- Community Emergency Management Program Committee meeting held in June, approved an updated Emergency Management Program By-law; proposed bylaw & evacuation agreement bylaw submitted for Council approval in July.
- 2 meetings with CAO/CEMC regarding Emergency Management control group training & Emergency Management program workloads, goals & objectives
- 1 Civic Address number issued for 2024 severance.
- 1 request for potable water for washroom facility under Fee-for-service provided to Insight Productions Ltd.
